

Our Privacy Policy

Personal contact information we collect and what we do with it

When you are making a donation or engaging in certain other activities on this Web site, we ask you for personal contact information, including your name, mailing address, phone number and e-mail address. We will use this contact information to provide you with information or resources you have requested, such as information about the Organization, a receipt or a financial report, or we will use your information to contact you to clarify or verify other information, such as a donation you made.

We will not add your name and contact information to any mailing lists without your prior knowledge or express permission. In other words, we will always ask or inform you before adding you to a mailing list. If we do not, you will not be added. If you have agreed to be added to one of our mailing lists, such as an e-mail newsletter list or regular mailing list, then you may receive news about the Organization and information on how you can support the organization's mission.

If you make a donation and agree to be added to our postal mailing list, we may contact you from time to time. Personal contact information is not shared with any organization outside of the Organization and our agents (reputable companies we use for services, such as shipping products or sending mail). We have contracts to protect your privacy with all of our agents.

Consistent with the Federal Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 (COPPA), we will never knowingly request personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13 without requesting parental consent.

We sometimes use the non-personally identifiable information that we collect to monitor user traffic patterns, analyze and quantify user preferences, improve the design and content of our Web site, and enable us to personalize your user experience. All such usage data shall be the exclusive property of this Web site.

Although we take appropriate measures to safeguard against unauthorized disclosures of information, we cannot assure you that personally identifiable information that we collect will never be disclosed or accessed by a third party in a manner that is inconsistent with this Privacy Policy.

We may on occasion combine information we receive online with outside records to enhance our ability to market to you those products and services that may be of interest to you. Personal billing information we collect and what we do with it

In addition to personal contact information, we ask for billing information, such as your billing address and credit card number, when you make a donation or purchase a product. We use secure servers to gather and process your billing information. These secure servers are hosted by our agents, Convio and Luquire George Andrews, which are bound by our site policies. Your billing information is not shared with any other organizations, and your credit card number is not retained once your transaction has been authorized and processed.

How to view or change your information

With the exception of credit card numbers, which are not retained, you can view and request changes to all the information you have given us, including any mailing lists you may be on, by emailing us.

Your IP address, cookies and plug-ins

For each visitor to our Web site, our Web server automatically recognizes the visitor's IP address (no personally identifiable information, such as e-mail addresses, are automatically recognized by our server). We use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server and to administer our Web site. Your IP address may also be used to gather broad demographic information. Occasionally, we may use session cookies to improve content, provide easier access and understand how visitors use our Web site. Session cookies are also used to support our e-commerce pages.
